
Hi! Our names are Adam (5 years) and Samuel (4 years) and we are brothers



Adam and Samuel have lived together with their foster family since April 2017.

Adam - "I like going on a day out to the farm feeding the animals and having a picnic. I also like playing in the garden, being on the trampoline and the swing. I enjoy being on my scooter. Indoors I like drawing, painting and doing puzzles."

Samuel - "I like being outdoors, I like going to the beach, park and soft play. I also like visiting farms and zoos. When I am in the garden I enjoy the trampoline and swing. Indoors, I like puzzles, games and playing with my cars and figures."

Adam is a very happy, enthusiastic, chatty and sociable little boy. His foster carer describes him as honest, caring and affectionate. He loves going to school and is extremely popular there; he is liked by students and teachers. Adam has a great sense of humour and loves nature and wildlife shows and documentaries. Adam also loves arts and crafts, stories, jigsaw puzzles, trampolining and lots of outdoor play at the park or beach. He can be a fussy eater and often won't eat meat. His favourite foods are meatballs and pasta, fruit and yoghurt. Adam enjoys matching television and films, his favourites are; Power Rangers, Mr Tumble, The Gruffalo, Peter Rabbit and Minions

Samuel is a fun loving, cheeky, lively and active little boy. Samuel loves watching Ninja Turtles and Spiderman, dressing up, dinosaurs and dragons and playing with building bricks, magnetix, cars and figures. Samuel loves to climb, particularly trees and climbing frames. He also loves outdoor play at the beach or park and riding his bike.



The children were removed from their birth parents care due to significant domestic violence between Samuel and Adam's birth parents, lack of engagement with support services and likely drugs and alcohol use.

Adam and Samuel have a positive relationship however they are starting to squabble which is manageable and appropriate. Adam and Samuel are very close and have a strong bond with each other. They play together well and enjoy each other's company.

Placement Orders were granted for the children in March 2019.

<u>Proposed contact</u>- Post placement contact is recommended at a level of 1 x yearly, 2 way Information Exchange for birth parents.

Contact in regards to their siblings (in long term foster care) is envisaged will be at a level of 2 way information exchange 2 x yearly in the first instance.
