


# Hi! We are Damien (4 years) and Sienna (1 ½ year) and we are brother and sister!

Damien and Sienna have witnessed domestic abuse between their parents, they were removed under police protection following one of those incidents. Before being placed in foster care they experienced neglectful care, lack of boundaries, supervision and daily structure. Since being placed in foster care both children have thrived.



Damien is making good progress now he is in foster care and he is enjoying the security of consistent routines and boundaries.

Damien has a bubbly, chatty and happy personality. He sleeps through the night and enjoys bath times and watching Octonauts and PJ Mask. He is very chatty and enjoys adults' company. He loves playing with cars, diggers and trucks. He enjoys the outdoor and socialising with other children.



Damien's favourites foods are watermelon, banana and a roast chicken dinner.

Damien is getting used to the safe care he is getting now, he sometimes still uses adult phrases and can occasionally demonstrate anger in his play. He attends school regularly and enjoys the interaction with the other children. He was recently invited to his first 'birthday party' since being placed in care.

Sienna is an alert baby who is walking well. She is described as a happy, affectionate baby who seeks the closeness of her carer. She eats and sleeps well. She was initially only used to baby food but now enjoys a variety of home cooked food.



Both children are healthy and meeting their developmental milestones. Damien and Sienna are of dual heritage. Their birth father is White British, and their birth mother is Caribbean, Nigerian and White British. We are looking for adopters who could reflect or promote the children's heritage.

Placement Orders were granted for the children in October 2019
