Daniel: *I really like singing and dressing up and will wear lots of things including a troll outfit and a Spiderman outfit. I enjoy playing with cars and trucks. At Christmas I got a new bike and learnt how to pedal it. At the moment I don't talk very much at school, but this is improving, and I am saying more at home.*

I like to eat fruit, but I don't like peas. My favourite colour is red like my new coat.

Cameron: *I like dressing up too and playing with toy cars and trucks. I really enjoy singing and doing actions to nursery rhymes with my carer and she says I chat nonstop. She also says I am cheerful.*

I don't like peas either. My favourite colour is orange, sometimes I pretend I don't know my colours and say lots of things are orange.

I go to nursery 2 ½ days a week and when I'm not there I love playing with my carer's granddaughter and we laugh a lot.

Daniel and Cameron have separate bedrooms now which works really well as Daniel is an early riser and Cameron sleeps later in the morning.

Daniel and Cameron have experienced significant neglect and poor home conditions.

Daniel & Cameron are to be placed together as only children within family. They require a high level of nurturing and re-parenting with attuned carers who are able to invest the time with the children. Prospective adopters should be able to provide a highly predictable routine.

Areas to avoid: Hatfield, Borehamwood or Eltham in London.
