Sarah is a happy, smiley, affectionate, cheeky, funny, and inquisitive little girl. She will always greet familiar people with a big grin! Sarah has a joy for life, she particularly loves dressing up, playing with balls and enjoys going out for a walk in her buggy, she regularly gets taken to farms/wildlife parks.

Sarah really enjoys music, the moment any music is played she will be up dancing and bouncing around. Her favourite nursery rhyme is the wheels on the bus.

Sarah lived with her brother and their birth parents until October 2018, in which they experienced neglect, little stimulation, and would have been exposed to domestic abuse.



Sarah has global developmental delay, associated with microcephaly. Sarah is making good progress in foster care, she still needs lots of guidance with every day activities including learning how to play, interacting socially and her speech and language, but is making positive improvements. Due to Sarah's developmental delay, she requires the same supervision as you would expect of a much younger child as she loves to explore! Sarah needs re-parenting so that she can progress through earlier developmental stages that she has missed out on early in life.

Legal status: Placement Order

Areas to avoid: Potters Bar, Barnet, Shenley, Borehamwood, Hatfield, Cornwall or Margate.

Proposed contact- Indirect contact with birth parents and possible direct contact with sibling.
