Timmy is cheeky, engaging, chatty and affectionate with the most endearing smile. Timmy has a really good sense of humour and he has a real belly laugh. Timmy loves spending time playing with his carer, he enjoys playing games, going on walks outdoors, riding his bike, feeding the ducks and regularly gets taken to the farm/wildlife parks. Timmy also really enjoys singing nursery rhymes, wearing his carer's slippers (which he finds very amusing!), and most importantly he absolutely loves dinosaurs! Timmy lived with his sister and their birth parents until October 2018, in which they experienced neglect, little stimulation, and would have been witness to domestic abuse. Due to this Timmy has Global Developmental Delay.



Timmy has global developmental delay, mainly with speech and language. He has made very good progress in foster care and his speech has greatly improved, he can now count, name all his colours, animals and dinosaurs, and can make all his wants and needs known. Timmy responds well to being in a routine and is making positive improvements. Timmy has started school, and is doing well with some additional support. Timmy needs re-parenting so he can progress through the developmental stages that he has missed out at an earlier stage of his life. Timmy requires a good amount of emotional support and reassurance so requires adopters that are empathic and understanding of this
